

Water conservation



Water conservation is important *all year round*. Water costs Upper Hutt city just as much to store, treat, and pump over winter as it does in summer.

To save money on your energy bills and our city's water bill, try these water conservation tips at home:



Only wash full loads of dishes and laundry.



Take shorter showers and/or install a water efficient shower head—hot water can be up to 40% of your energy bill.



Don't run the tap when preparing food, use a bowl of water or plug the sink instead.



Water restrictions are in place all year around in Upper Hutt

A single sprinkler system, irrigation system, soaker hose or an unattended hose may be used in your garden from 6–8 am and 7–9 pm, but only on the following days.

Tue – Thu – Sat: odd numbered houses only

Wed – Fri – Sun: even numbered houses only
